Dear Dundas Residents:

The City will be changing garbage haulers from Waste Management (WM) to Dick's Sanitation, Inc (DSI) beginning January 1st, 2018. **During the transition the last pickup by WM will be Friday, December 29th.** After WM has picked up the garbage, please leave your empty WM garbage cart out to be removed.

DSI will be dropping off your garbage cart on December 28th or the 29th. DSI's first garbage pickup will be on Friday, January 5th, 2018 (due to Holiday). Recycling pickup will be every two weeks and will begin on Thursday, January 11th, 2018. Christmas Tree pickup will be on Friday, January 5th and Thursday January 11th, at no charge to you. **REMINDER: Keep carts off the street.**

Garbage service will continue to be picked up on Thursdays from 8 AM to 6 PM (except when holidays occur earlier in the week, then pickup will be on Friday). **The recycling carts will stay the same and no exchange will be required.**

Residents with questions regarding service after January will call DSI Customer Service directly at 952-469-5161, Monday through Friday, for missed pickups, cart damages, change of cart size, extra pickups, bulk items, etc.

Single Sort Recycling

Recycling is easy with Single Sort! Place all items loose in your cart. Please DO NOT BAG these items. Roll cart to the end of your driveway EVERY OTHER WEEK on your service day.

- Glass (Vidrio)**
 - Thoroughly rinse bottles and jars
 - Remove caps and rings
 - Avoid breaking
 - All colors
- Plastics #1-7 (Botellas de plástico #1-7)**
 - Beverage Bottles
 - Food Packaging
 - Food Containers
 - DO NOT INCLUDE
 - Plastic Bags
 - Packing Peanuts
 - Styrofoam
- Cans (Latas de aluminio y acero)**
 - Food and beverage cans
 - Thoroughly rinse
 - Labels do not need to be removed
 - Please, no bags
- Paper and Cardboard (Papel y Cartón)**
 - All first class mail
 - All white & light colored paper (includes envelopes)
 - Recycled paper
 - Computer paper
 - Magazines, Newspapers
 - Catalogs, Telephone books, Paperback books
 - Cardboard
